

E-Flite helis have a lot of tiny, fragile parts. But these micros are so small that they are very fragile, every big crash is going to cost you money in repair parts. E-Flite is notorious for charging exorbitantly high prices for their spare parts.

The new generation of helis are direct drive with very few parts to replace. For example, the Ohio Model Products (OMP) M2 Explore comes highly reviewed and recommended. The direct drive motor means no gears and no belts. The swash links are one piece; nothing to adjust. Servos are metal geared and strip resistant. I have an M1 and have crashed inverted with no damage several times. But, I would suggest an M2 to learn on.
