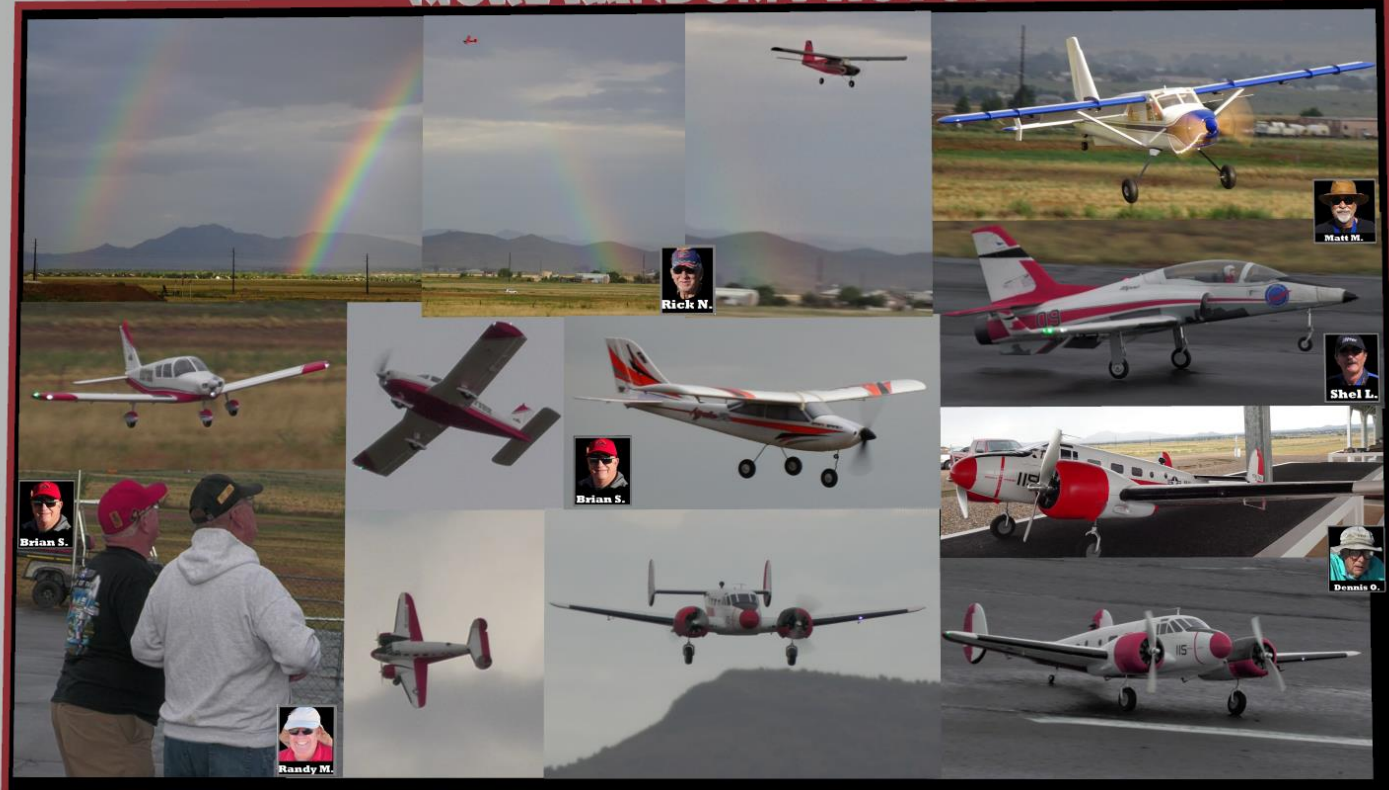

Frank says he put some yellow on the wings so he can see it.



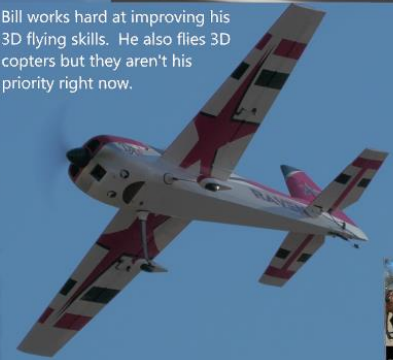
Looks good in the air but hard to believe Shel will fly this slow for long.

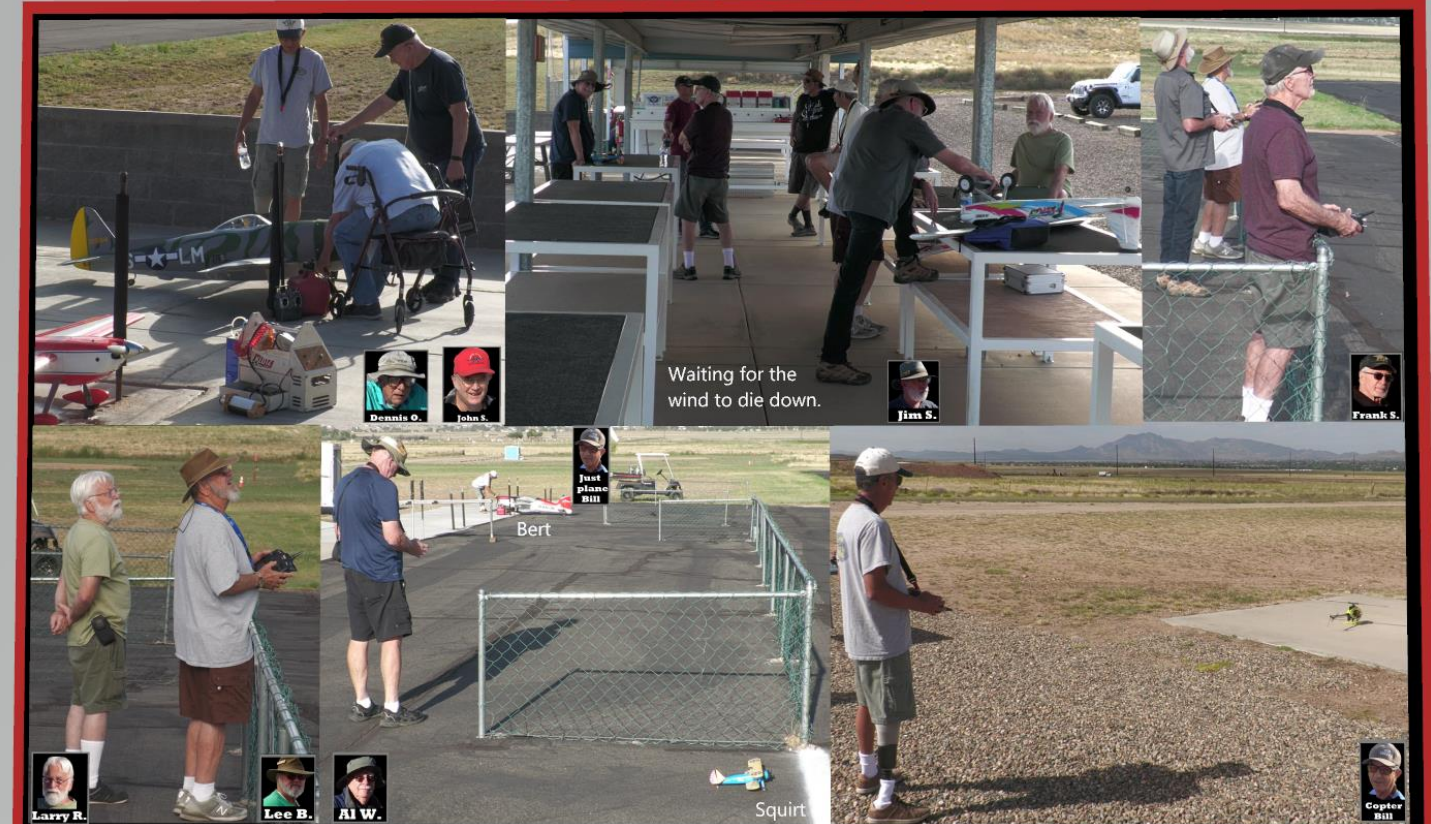

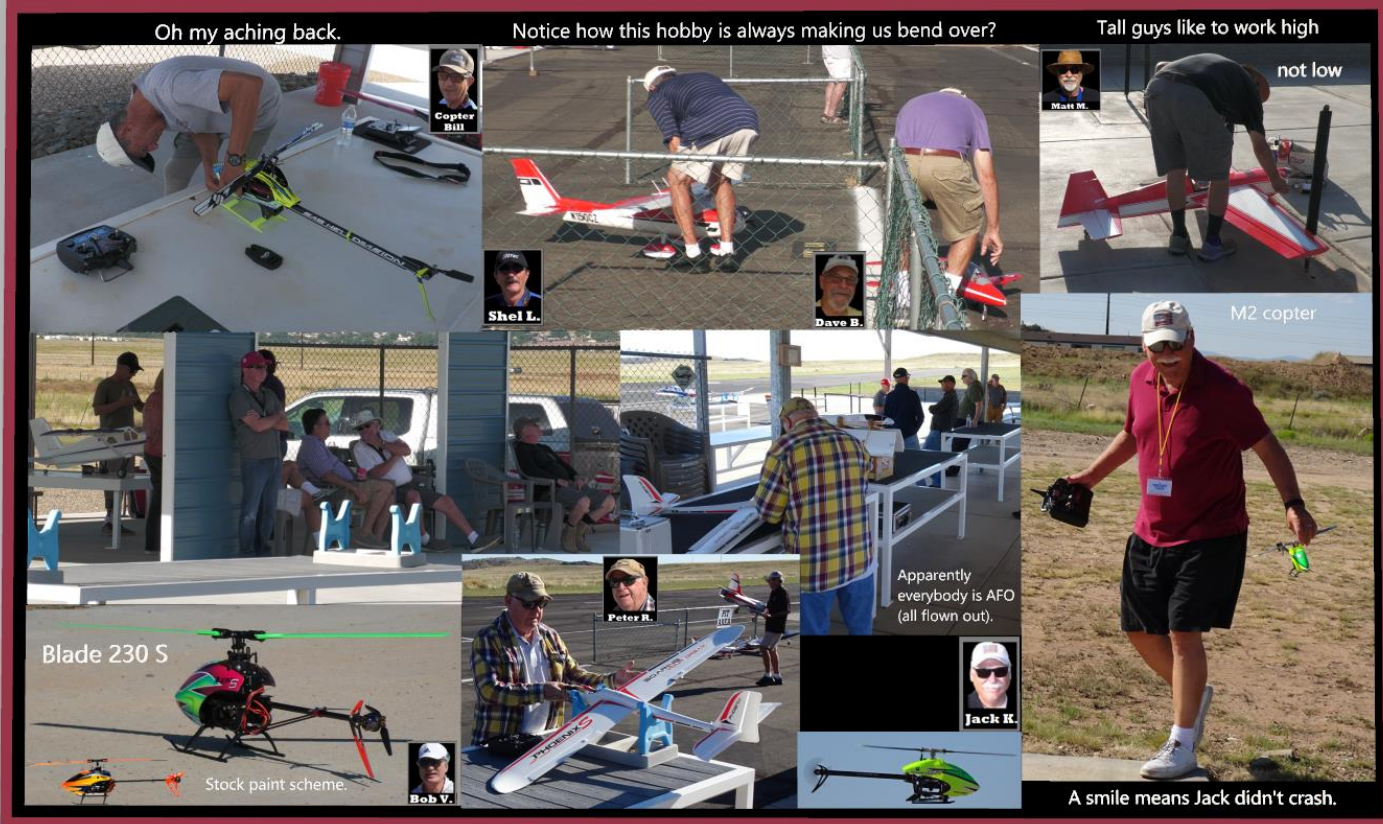


Vertical take-off

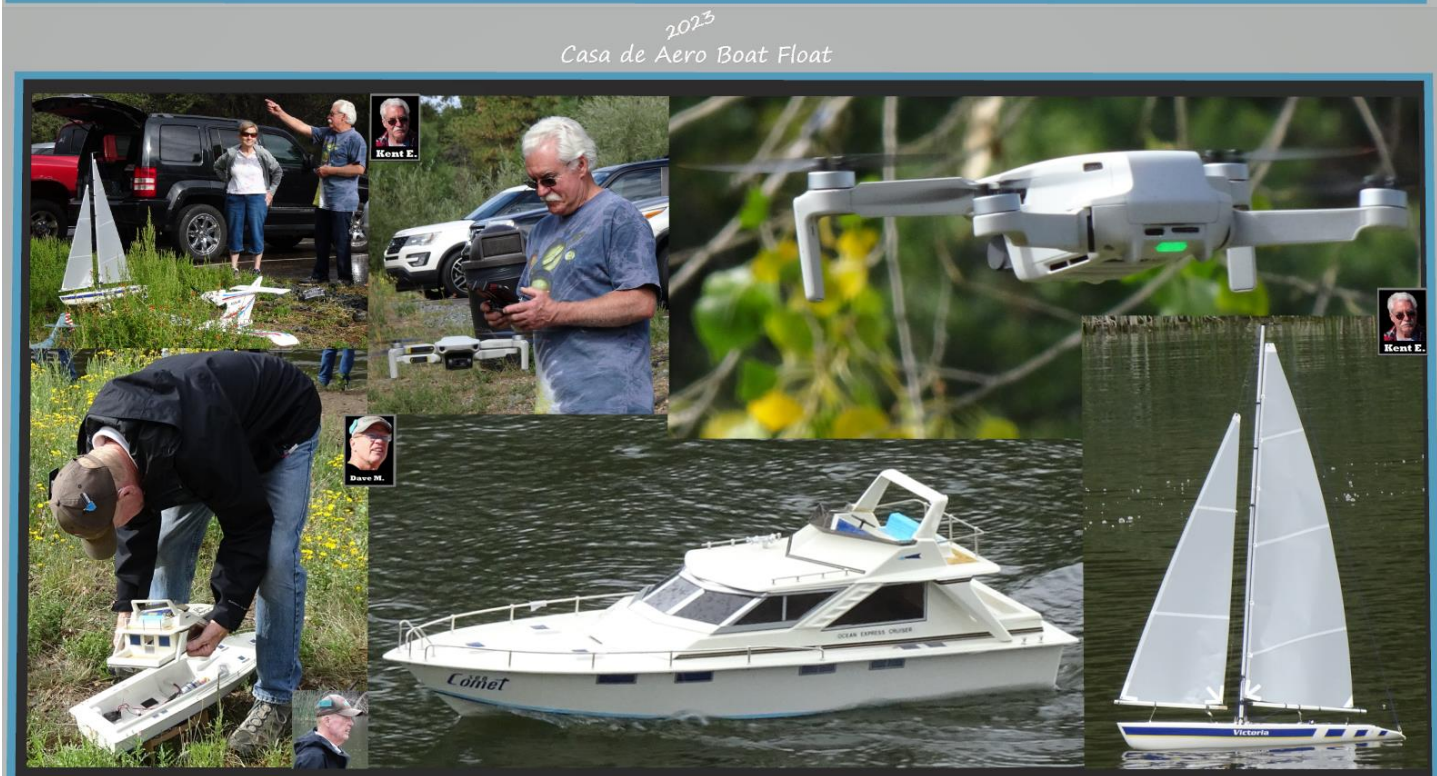
