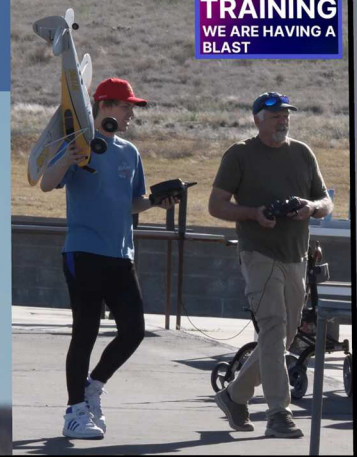

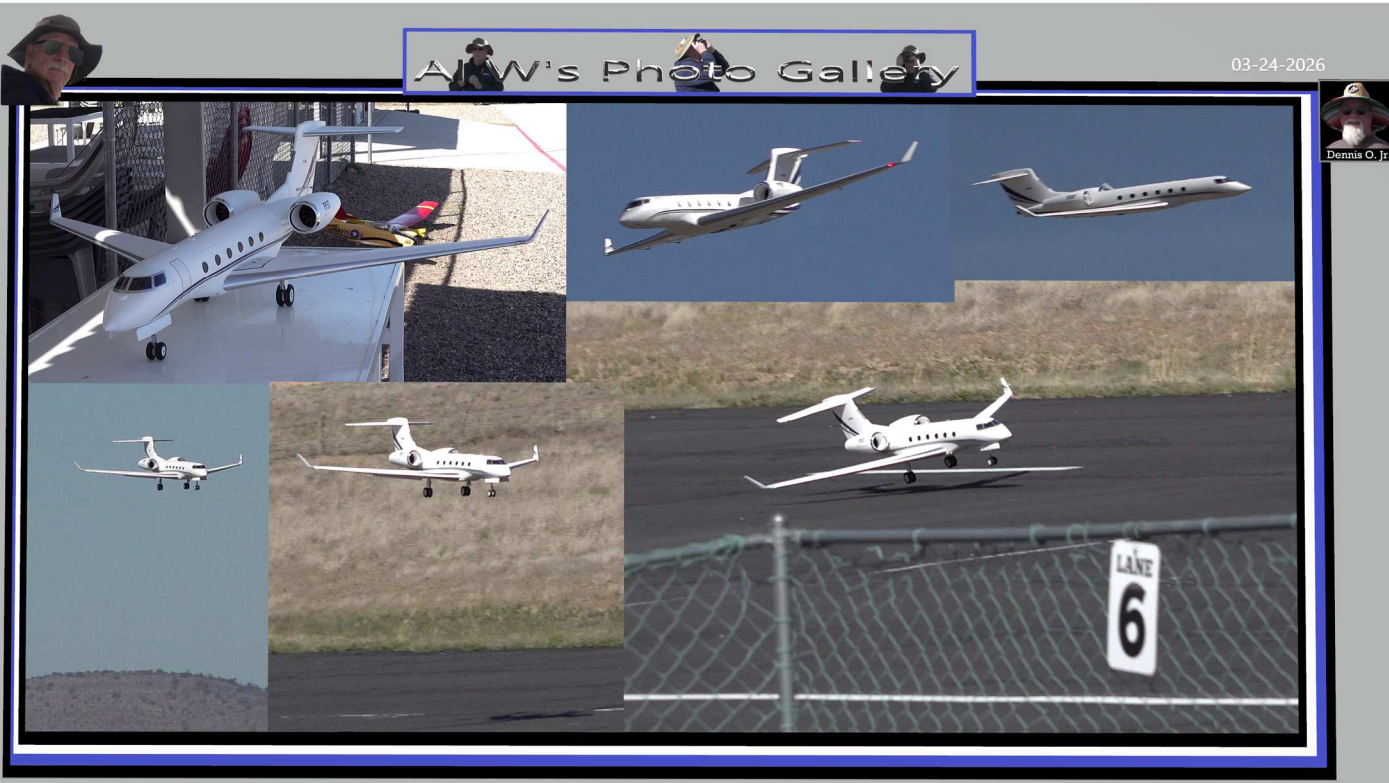

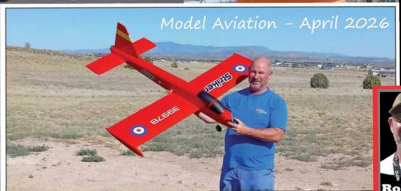

Striker Classic Pattern Airplane 3rd time in ModelAv for Robert!

Robert Fish's (Paulden, Arizona; email: robert.fish.aerobatics@gmail.com) Striker was originally featured as a construction article in the February 1968 edition of the British publication *Radio Control Models and Electronics*. It was built from a KYM Manufacturing laser-cut kit.

The airplane is of all-wood construction and is powered by an Innov8ive Designs BadAss 3530-700 electric motor and ESC. It took approximately 100 hours to build and is covered with red UltraCote.

"The model exceeded all of my expectations in flight," said Robert. "[It is] very stable and performs all Classic Pattern maneuvers with ease and grace."

He uses the hobby as a way to relax and focus, having originally started it over 20 years ago to help overcome a fear of flying after 9/11 . Operating from a private 2,000-foot runway located at his "mega mansion" in Atlanta, Perry collaborates with expert builders like Ramy RC to create and fly massive, custom-built scale models.
